Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Newport, New Hampshire will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, April 29, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. for the following purpose:

to hear public comment on a proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application to the NH Community Development Finance Authority (CDFA). Up to \$500,000 annually is available to municipalities or counties on a competitive basis for economic development projects, housing and public facility projects, and emergency activities. Up to \$12,000 is available for feasibility study grants. All projects must directly benefit a majority of low- and moderate-income persons. The proposal to be heard includes:

- A proposed CDBG feasibility grant application for up to \$12,000 to fund a study to examine the feasibility of a workforce child care center in Newport.
- Review and Adoption of Newport's Residential Anti-displacement and Relocation Plan for the proposed project.
- Review and adaptation of the Town of Newport's Housing and Community Development Plan.
