

TOWN OF NEWPORT, NH Board of Selectmen PUBLIC NOTICE – April 5, 2021; 6:30 p.m.

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Newport, New Hampshire will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 5, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the Newport Town Offices at 15 Sunapee Street, Newport, New Hampshire to hear public comment on the progress of the Town's Transportation Corridor Market Study.

<u>Background:</u> In January of 2020, the Town of Newport was awarded a \$12,000 Community Development Block Grant from the Community Development Finance Authority to conduct a feasibility study of the need for a busing route from Newport to the Upper Valley (Hanover, Lebanon, Enfield area) and how that potential bus route would improve accessibility to employment, healthcare, and regional commerce. The funds were used to hire a consulting firm to complete the study.

<u>Action:</u> This mid-grant public hearing is required by 24 CFR 570.486 and NH RSA 162-L:14 in order to receive public input and advise Newport citizens on the progress of this project. No action is required by the Board of Selectmen.
