Board of Selectmen Minutes for Budget Review Meeting February 13, 2017; 6:30 pm Municipal Building

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Kessler called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Newport Public Works Department

I. Waste Water Treatment Facility

The Board of Selectmen addressed Mr. Greenleaf and asked him for his review. He stated the budget was basically a flat line budget and no Capital Items were being requested in fiscal year 2017-2018. No Capital Items would be requested until they knew what they'd do with the upgrade. Chairman Kessler asked if there were questions from the Board. Board members asked questions on:

Fuel (oil and propane) Chemical Supplies (current fiscal year) Preventative maintenance A request to explain Toxicity Tests Monitor Well Testing

All questions were answered by Mr. Greenleaf and Mr. Wiggins.

Chairman Kessler asked Mr. Green leaf for an update on the upgrade. Mr. Greenleaf stated that pilots were tested in November 2016 and another testing should be done (outside firm) mid-February 2017.

Chairman Kessler thanked Mr. Greenleaf for attending the meeting.

Mr. Greenleaf left the meeting at 6:48 pm.

II. Highway Department

Chairman Kessler addressed Mr. Scanlon concerning his budget. He had not seen it prior to the meeting. He had no questions. Mr. Wiggins stated he had made reductions to several (8) line items; he tried to be a "lean" as he could. Board members asked questions on the following:

The number of part-time laborers - Part<u>-time</u> laborers should read <u>per diem</u>. Mr. Wiggins explained the use of per diems for the Board.

- Overtime. Mr. Scanlon and Mr. Wiggins answered all questions.
- * Radio and radio maintenance. Mr. Wiggins explained there had not been a replacement of his base unit when the Town did the major radio upgrade in 2016. The Board and Mr. Wiggins discussed this line item further.
- Mowing (roadside)

Mr. Spaulding, Sr. stated the Japanese Knot Weed that the Town was mowing was an invasive species. His suggestion was to not cut it. He explained that VT had a program (using chemicals) to eradicate it. Mr. Spaulding, Sr. had an informational sheet concerning the program. He was asked to submit it to Town Manager Rieseberg.

Mr. Scanlon was asked if his department had had difficulties plowing during the recent snowstorms. Mr. Scanlon gave the status (number) and experience of his drivers. He explained to the BOS and took full responsibility. Selectman Fratzel complained about the poor plowing. He told Mr. Scanlon and Mr. Wiggins the responsibility was theirs.

Mr. Bert Spaulding, Sr. suggested that the Highway Department pay per diem drivers (experienced) more money. Chairman Kessler asked that Mr. Wiggins and Mr. Scanlon present a new plan to the Town Manager.
