Facilities constructed in violation of these conditions shall be corrected immediately upon notification by a Department representative or the costs of removing said facility shall be fully borne by the owner.

LOCATION:

DRIVEWAY CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS:

1.	This permit requires that the area adjacent to the street be graded such that the surface will slope from the edge of pavement to a linefeet distant from and parallel to the pavement and inches below the edge of pavement (for the entire frontage of the property), which line will serve as a drainage gutter.			
2.	driveway entrance(s) is (are) permissible, each not to exceed feet in width. The driveway entrance(s) may be flared as they approach the pavement.			
3.	Other access to the street from the premises is to be prevented by construction of a barrier or barriers, such as a gras low hedge, curbed island, etc. The front of this barrier island shall be feet from the edge of pavement and the edge at the right-of-way line. No part of the right-of-way may be used for any purpose other than travel.			
4.	No structures, including buildings, permanent or portable signs, light displays, fences, walls, etc. shall be permitted on, over or under the street right-of-way.			
5.	The street right-of-way line is located feet from and parallel to the center line of highway pavement.			
6.	No parking, catering or servicing shall be conducted within the street right-of-way.			
7.	A culvert is to be located in the ditch line. The culvert is to be feet long and inches in diameter. Both ends of the culvert shall be protected by a headwall of: a) stone (12" minimum diameter), b) concrete or c) an end section. Culverts and ditch lines shall be constructed to prevent erosion and to not obstruct the flow of stormwater.
