PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Newport, New Hampshire will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 3, 2020 at 6:30 PM at the Newport Town Offices at 15 Sunapee Street, Newport, New Hampshire to hear public comment on a proposal to authorize the use of the Town of Newport's Public Safety Off Highway Recreational Vehicle (OHRV) on certain roadways. Pursuant to NH-RSA 215-A:15 city or town councils and boards of selectmen may authorize the use of sidewalks and class IV, class V or class VI highways and bridges, or portions thereof, for use by OHRVs. The proposal to be heard includes:

- Authorization for members of the Newport Police and Fire Department to operate the Town owned OHRV on sidewalks and class IV, class V or class VI highways and bridges, or portions thereof, during non-emergency operations.
