## **Temporary Food Vendors Policy**

## Approved by the BOS on May 17, 2004

In order to obtain permission to sell food from a mobile food service set-up, the following steps shall be taken:

## On Town Owned Land:

- 1) The applicant must have either a "Hawkers/Peddler's" permit from the State of NH, or a Food Service License (renewed annually) from the same.
- 2) The Planning Administrator or Town Manager must approve of the location of the potential setup.
- 3) The following questions must be answered:
  - a. How long will the set-up remain on site?
  - b. Will you take up any parking or sidewalk space?
  - c. How will trash be taken care of?
  - d. Are the local Booster clubs or athletic teams selling any food items? The applicant must check with the Athletic Director at the High School, or the Athletic League Official (Please note that the Newport Tigers Football Booster Club <u>does</u> sell food items during their season).
  - e. Permission may be rescinded at will by the Town of Newport.

On Private land:

- 1) The applicant must have either a "Hawkers/Peddler's" permit from the State of NH, or a Food Service License (renewed annually) from the same.
- 2) The land owner must approve of the location of the potential set-up.
- 3) If the set-up is removed nightly, and is in an area zoned for a restaurant, approval by the ZBA will not be necessary.
- 4) If left for more than 24 hours or if any accessory items are left on site, then ZBA approval will be required.
