Camping Information

- 1) Camping is offered on a first-come, first-served basis, as camping space is available.
- 2) Camping is available in the trees west of runway 18-36, and on the grass south of runway 12-30.
- 3) Campers may park aircraft and erect tents south of runway 12/30.
- 4) Campers must observe the obstruction-free zone 125 feet either side of the runway 18-36 center line and cannot park aircraft, erect tents, etc., within the obstacle-free zone.
- 5) Camping is primitive. There are no specially prepared camp sites.
- 6) Camping is not available at the picnic tables near the covered bridge. This area is a Town Park and overnight camping is not permitted in the Town Park.
- 7) The Airport Operations Building is open to pilots 24/7 via key code lock. The Operations Building has one restroom with sink and toilet. There are no shower facilities available on the field.
- 8) Bicycles are available for campers' use in the community hangar. Bicycles are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 9) Public picnic tables are available for daytime use by the covered bridge at the approach end of runway 12.
- 10) Campers are responsible for the care and security of their aircraft and camping equipment.
- Tie-downs are available on the east side of the field, without charge for campers, per the Parlin Field Tie-Down procedures.
- The Airport holds a Permit for open fires in the Camp Fire Area west of Runway 18-36, directly across from the mid-field taxiway. This is the only location at which campers may build open fires. Campers must observe the Permit Conditions and Restrictions posted in the Airport Operations Building.
- 13) A fire permit is not required for self-contained camp stoves. Campers may use self-contained stoves at their campsite for cooking purposes.
- 14) Campers are encouraged to make a donation to the Parlin Pilots fund for airport improvements.
- 15) These procedures are subject to periodic review, which may result in a change of terms.
