

News and Events at the Parlin Field Airport in Newport, New Hampshire February 2012

Winter Carnival!

Looking for a place to fly? Maybe someplace that offers food and fun for you and your flying companion? Parlin Field might be the place! The Newport Winter Carnival offers more than 50 events ranging from a sliding party to a Jazz Quartet. Events begin Sunday, February 5 and run through Sunday, February 12.



Only a few events actually depend on snow. One of those is Ski Joring, an event in which skiers are pulled along an obstacle course by horse and rider in a manner similar to water skiing. Ski Joring is held on the turf runway which is closed in winter, so the paved runway and airport remain open. Obviously, the event depends on adequate snow cover, and as of February 1 the airport had very little snow cover. But don't be deterred by the lack of snow. Many fun events occur at the High School about ½ mile from the airport. Others occur on the Town Common less than 2 miles from the airport. Flying Activity Remains Steady

Flying activity has been somewhat greater this winter, when compared with previous years. Perhaps the relatively mild winter with little snow explains the increase. In any case, fuel sales in January are nearly double January sales from previous years. Operations have increased from previous years, and local pilots are more active.

Some of this winter's flying has been fantastic with several days featuring 100+ mile visibility in smooth air. Local pilots and visitors from throughout the northeast have commented on the flying conditions. One pilot on a flight from Maine described an unusual atmospheric phenomenon in which an inversion layer

apparently obscured distant mountains and made the horizon appear as a flat-topped mesa. Others have described the great performance they experience from their aircraft due to the very low density altitudes, in many cases hundreds of feet below sea level. As one pilot put it "If you didn't like flying today, you just don't like flying!"
