Ice Age

Heavy rains on January 30th caused the Sugar River to over flow her banks and deposit numerous large sheets of ice on the south end of Runway 18/36. The ice flow took out five of the six runway threshold lights. Pilot **Terry Callum**, was quick to respond to the clean up effort by getting the airport Bobcat machine running to break up and move the heavy sheets of ice from the runway. The runway lights were NOTAM'd out of service for a brief time while pilots **Rocky Cusanelli** and **Terry Callum** along with airport managers **Heath Marsden** and **Rick Kloeppel** repaired the five

threshold lights. The runway and associated lighting was back to normal operation the following day.
