Runway CLOSED for Paving



Runway 18/36 will be closed from sunrise Tuesday morning, July 12 until Thursday evening, July 14 for repairs and paving. We intend to keep the turf runway 12/30 open as much as possible, but pilots can expect the

turf runway to be closed at any time. Pilots should check <u>NOTAMs</u> for exact closure dates and times. The airport (but not the runways) will remain open for DHART and other helicopter traffic that can utilize taxiway and tie-down areas that are well clear of construction activities.

Pilots based at Parlin Field who want to fly during the runway closure should consider repositioning their airplane to Claremont or another airport.

Once paving is complete, it will be several days before we can paint the runway centerline, threshold, or other markings. The unmarked runway may present some challenges for arriving and departing aircraft, particularly during nighttime operations. Again, pilots should consult <u>NOTAMs</u> for runway conditions and restrictions on operations.

Hangar Work Continues

Thanks to dedicated work from Terry Callum, the structural frame for a new hangar door has been installed on the old Parlin Field Hangar. Terry set the frame



in place with help from a crane and operator provided by **LaValley Building Supply**. Once the frame was in place, Terry bolted and welded the frame to the existing hangar structure. The frame will provide the structural strength necessary to support a new one-piece hangar door.

Now that the frame is in place, we can determine exact dimensions for the door. We are working out final design details with the door manufacturer and expect to order the door in the next few days.

Do You Read NOTAMs?

The system for providing Notices to Airmen isn't perfect and the cryptic abbreviations are sometimes puzzling, but NOTAMs provide information for your safety and the safety of people and property on the ground. Certainly, some NOTAMs are trivial, but others are absolutely critical. Recent NOTAMs included airport closure at Parlin Field for the Run What Ya' Brung event and temporary traffic pattern changes to avoid aerobatic areas at Keene. Knowing these facts makes your flight go more smoothly. Ignorance is not necessarily bliss. Need help with NOTAMs? Contact your favorite flight instructor or FAA Safety Team representative.
