Welcoming back the Comanche's

On June 21st the International Comanche Society - Northeast Tribe (ICS-NE) made Parlin Field the destination for their fifth fly-in of the season. The ICS-NE is comprised of members from 13 northeast states, including Virginia north to New York and through the New England States. The weather was perfect for the arrival of 15 Piper Comanche aircraft and 1 Piper Warrior airplane. People flew in from as far north as Newport VT, as far west as Rochester NY, and as far south as Philadelphia PA. Most were from Mass and Connecticut.



While at Parlin Field, pilots and passengers dined at the Lil' Red Baron on the airport and then attended an FAA Safety Team (FAST) seminar on practical cockpit how-to tips and tricks with portable electronic devices such as iPads and Android tablets.



The aircraft parking ramp was busy as several additional aircraft arrived to attend the seminar. The seminar was given by our own John Merriman, Russ Kelsea and Rick Kloeppel. All-in-all, approximately 25 aircraft from across New England and beyond, flew in to enjoy our airport and its surroundings.

We had the pleasure of meeting Don and Michelle Steen later the same day as they arrived looking to kick back and journey the back roads of rural America. The couple set up camp under the wing of their aircraft and then took to the roads of Newport on a pair of airport bikes.
