Turf Runway Open

Parlin's turf Runway 12-30 was officially open on May 15. The runway is 1,980' long and is marked on each side and at the thresholds with yellow cones. The runway was recently rolled to smooth out any bumps and heaves from the winter thaw. Thanks to the Newport Highway Department! The Newport Building and Grounds crew has been keeping the grass on the turf runway as well as the grass along the sides of Runway 18-36 nicely trimmed and looking great. We are very fortunate to have an outstanding and cooperative relationship with other Town departments to keep our airport looking sharp!

Ramp Presence...

The Perras brothers, Yon and Uwanne chose Parlin Field as the destination for their first flight of the 2014 flying season. The brothers flew their 1943 Beechcraft Staggerwing D175 from Perras Field (VT44) in Morrisville, VT to Parlin to enjoy some Mexican cuisine at the Lil' Red Baron restaurant located on the airport. The brothers acquired the Beechcraft as a project plane back in 1982. They spent 8,000 man hours and four years restoring the aircraft. The first flight after the restoration took place in 1986. The fruits of their labor resulted in a picture perfect aircraft admired by aviators and non-aviators alike.
