Powered up at Parlin

The New England Chute Flyers found a home at Parlin Field during the weekend of September 20th-22nd. The gathering of 9 powered parachutes brought many townspeople out to the airport to get a close-up look of the unique aircraft as they soared overhead. The group made use of airport facilities throughout their stay including the operations building, community hangar, recently cleared camping spots and the manicured grass alongside Runway 18-36 at Parlin.

A rare and beautiful sight

This gorgeous Lockheed 12A paid a visit to Parlin Field on a picture perfect September day. The Lockheed is reminiscent of days gone by and provides a feeling of nostalgia as it sits parked in front of Parlin's Callum Community hangar. The hangar was

originally constructed in 1929 by relatives of Jim and Terry Callum, two of Parlin Field's most valued volunteers.

Filling a void

At it again, the Parlin team takes advantage of a warm day to complete runway crack sealing of Runway 18-36. A strong turnout of volunteers made quick work of sealing cracks along the length of the runway as well as the taxiways and aircraft parking apron. This routine pavement maintenance extends the life of the pavement by preventing water from entering common pavement cracks and eroding the base material or freezing and expanding the crack in the winter months.
