Tie-Down Information

- 1) Tie-downs are available on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no assigned tie-downs.
- 2) Tie-downs are free for the first 2 nights. After 2 nights, tie-down fees are \$3 nightly, not to exceed \$25 in any month.
- 3) Fees are payable to "Town of Newport, Parlin Field" and may be left with the airport manager or mailed to the airport address (above).
- 4) Two tie-down spaces are on pavement, but only the eastern tie-down is available for use because the western tie-down impinges on the adjacent taxiway. Six tie-downs are on mowed turf areas adjacent to the main ramp. See tie-down map below. Tie-down rings are marked with yellow paint.
- 5) Airport management may reposition aircraft at any time for any reason.
- 6) Tie-down tenants are responsible for the care and security of their aircraft, and are responsible for any damage they cause to other aircraft.
- 7) Tie-down tenants are expected to chock wheels and secure their aircraft with ropes or other devices as they deem necessary, but shall not use brakes, wheel locks, or other devices that restrict ground-handling.
- 8) Tie-down fees are non-refundable.
- 9) These procedures are subject to periodic review, which may result in a change of terms including a change in tie-down fees.
- 10) Tie-down space is provided for aircraft only. Other objects such as oil cartons, fuel cans, lockers, and other equipment shall not be stored on or near the tie-down.
- 11) Bicycles are available in the community hangar, on a first-come, first-served basis.
