As a Volunteer Coach with the Newport Recreation Department, I will:

- 1. Consider it a honor and a privilege to coach the young people of our community.
- 2. Keep in mind at all times that I am a youth sports coach and that the recreational experience is for the children not for the adults.
- 3. Use positive coaching methods to make the experience enjoyable for my players, increase their selfesteem and foster in them a true sense of enjoyment of the sport in which they are engaged.
- 4. Treat officials, opposing coaches and opposing players with respect and dignity and encourage my players and my players' parents to do the same.
- 5. Model grace, dignity and composure regardless of the outcome of the game.
- 6. Observe all player participation rules and strive to make each player feel as if he/she is a valuable member of the team regardless of any physical or developmental limitations he/she may have.
- 7. Teach the principles of fair play and sportsmanship to my players and model these principles for them at all times.
- 8. Strive to learn the rules of the game and teach those rules to my players and their parents as best I
- 9. Encourage safe play at all times and report any unsafe playing conditions to the Newport Recreation Department as soon as I am able.
- 10. Refrain from using any illegal substances or tobacco products, or imbibing alcohol in the presence of my players or on school or park property.
- 11. Report any conduct that violates this code or adversely affects the positive, kid-friendly environment of the Newport Recreation Department athletic programs.
