JOB DESCRIPTION

STATUS: Part time, various hours

Job Summary:

Under the supervision and guidance of the Recreation Supervisor, the Youth Sports Volunteer Coach is responsible for providing a safe and fun atmosphere for each child who has registered for the program through the Newport Recreation Dept.

Coaches will have basic knowledge of the skills and rules to play the game. They will also have an understanding of the importance of teaching teamwork and sportsmanship to children. It is expected that the coach be a positive role model while in the presence of any and all participants involved with the recreation program.

- Genuine interest in being a positive influence in a youth's life.
- Understanding of the duties and responsibilities it takes to be a successful youth coach.
- Stays current of sport specific rules, drills and strategies.
- Updated certification in NYSCA sport specific training.
